

New Orleans Schools' Charter Renewals:

Overview & Timelines

Overview

All charter schools in New Orleans have a "charter" or contract with their authorizing body which outlines their operational terms and conditions including their mission, program, and performance standards. All schools are required to renew their school charters on a regular basis. This process involves submitting an application to, and receiving approval from, their authorizing body. Currently, the OPSB is in the process of finalizing new standards and guidelines for all OPSB charter renewals that will be implemented under unification in 2018-2019.¹ Once those standards are in place, the Cowen Institute will release a brief detailing the process and terms of renewal. Until then, we have produced visual timelines illustrating all upcoming charter renewals for schools in New Orleans. The aim is for these graphs to provide quick and easy information to school leaders, educators, non-profits, parents, and community members on when certain schools are facing the renewal process.

How to read these graphs

There are two timelines included in this packet. The first features a timeline ranging from the 2017-2018 school year to the 2026-2027 school year, with schools facing renewals in each year listed alphabetically below. This allows the reader to identify which schools are up for renewal in a particular year. The graph also flags schools that are required to submit an extension application in a given year, as well as schools with state-issued letter scores of D or F. Schools with low school performance scores are at risk of not having their charter renewed so it's important to highlight this when discussing renewal. The second timeline features all charter schools in alphabetical order, allowing the reader to easily find the renewal year for a particular school by name.
